SHARING ACTIVITY

SPELLINGS

Your child was issued with a spelling list this week. Please encourage them to practise the words at home. Some weeks the words will be easier than others but they should be practised to ensure they are not only spelt correctly but are also legible (letters are formed correctly and clear to read). As the letter that accompanied the list said, spellings will be checked every Tuesday and new lists given. Sometimes words are repeated, this is often because children are not applying their knowledge in writing even though they can spell them in the check.
