

Personal, Social and Emotional Development (PSED)

The children will:

- continue to learn about the zones of regulation and begin to apply it to their own experiences (How do I feel? How can I self regulate?)
- Work together to create products
- Begin to develop their understanding of how their brain works as part of our 'My Happy Mind' training

Expressive Art and Design (EAD)

The children will:

- Make props for our class role play areas
- Explore and experiment with materials to create their own vegetable superhero.
- Continue to select and use resources as part of their independent learning.

Literacy

Through Phonics this term the children will:

- Continue to learn letter sounds (including Phase 3 sounds)
- Develop letter formation to write letters, words and sentences
- Blend to read words and sentences

Through the Supertato stories, the children will:

- Write sentences about Supertato and Evil Pea
- Create and write about their own superhero
- Create wanted posters with sentences about missing villains

Communication and Language

We will continue to develop language and vocabulary through storytime. The children will also:

- Participate in class and small group discussions about superheroes
- Learn new vocabulary linked to Chromebooks
- Describe learning experiences in detail
- Ask and answer questions about people in our community
- Offer explanations for events that happen (such as freeing superheroes when they are trapped!)

Hooks/Trips/Visitors

- The Dental students from Portsmouth University will visit us to explain their role in helping others and the importance of good oral hygiene.
- The children will have opportunities to try a range of fruit and vegetables
- We are excited to welcome people from our local community into the school and to visit Tangier Road and learn more about our local superheroes

Maths

The children will learn to:

- Recognise numbers
- represent them pictorially and in their written form
- Double numbers
- Find one more and one less than a given number
- Explore mass and capacity

Understanding the World (UTW)

The children will:

- Understand the role that people within our community have
- Understand the technology that is used at home and in school
- Talk about past and present events in their own lives and that of family members
- Explore cold places around the world
- Begin to understand the seasons and the role that they play in our lives

Physical Development (PD)

The children will

- Practise travelling like superheroes
- Travel in different ways
- Develop fine and gross motor skills
- Use bikes, go-karts and climbing equipment as part of Continuous Provision
- Learn dances as a celebration of Chinese New Year
